

Rules

Runners to be under 13 years of age as at 1st July this year.

Runners must register or confirm by 10.30 am on the day.

Runners must pay an entry fee of \$1.

Runners must run in shorts and should wear school tops.

Heats will be run to determine finalists.

Times for runners in all heats will be recorded if possible.

Winners of heats will be finalists.

The remaining finalists will be determined by fastest times.

Entrants younger than 11 may be handicapped in heats but not in finals. Guidelines for handicapping:

12 and 11 year olds – from scratch,	10 year olds - 2 metres
9 year olds - 4 metres	8 year olds - 6 metres
7 year olds - 8 metres	6 year olds - 10 metres

Primary Challenge for schools' points will be allocated from finals results as follows:

First	50	fifth	12
Second	30	sixth	9
Third	20	seventh	6
Fourth	15	eighth	4

The school with the greatest combined finals points total from their best four shall be the winners of the Perpetual Shield. In the event of a tie the school with most finalists will be deemed the winner. If still a tie the school with the highest placegetter will win. If still a tie then the team school with the fastest timed runner for the day shall win.
